


PROBLEMS, PROBLEMS, WHY PROBLEMS?


... God causes <u>all</u>

Romans 8:28


Scripture says that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love Him and are called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28). Is this true in your experience as well as in your theological belief? If so, do you become aware of the process only after the good has been worked out? Do you know God's heart and walk with Him, so that you can rejoice in the completion of God's good purpose while actually *in the pressures* of the moment?

Seek to understand the experiences of your life from God's perspective. Victorious Christian living is rooted in victorious Christian thinking—especially in regard to the problems of life. There are three kinds of problems in life: (1) problems God allows for His glory, (2) problems God allows because He loves us and wants to bring us to maturity, (3) problems that are the result of our own wrong choices.
